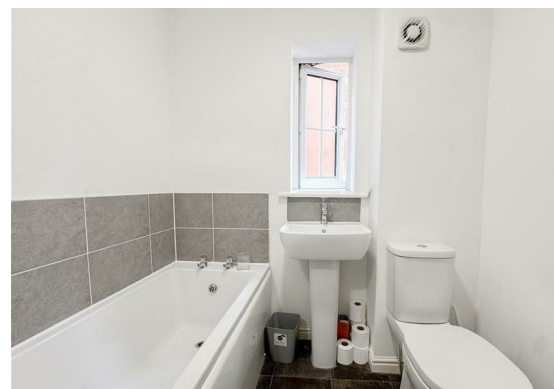

Floor Plan

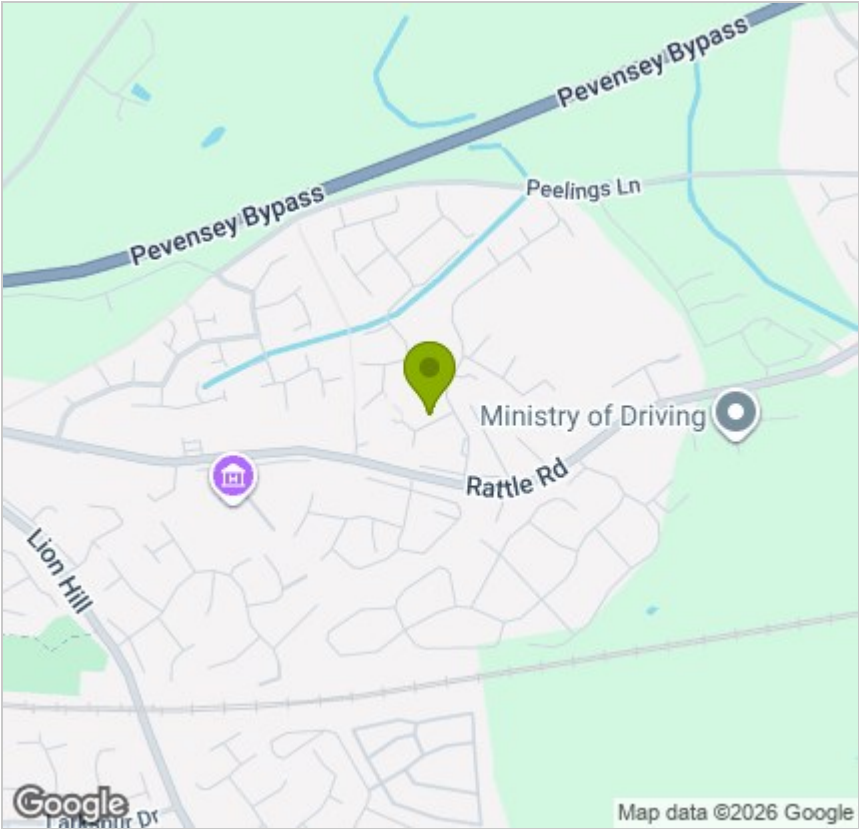
