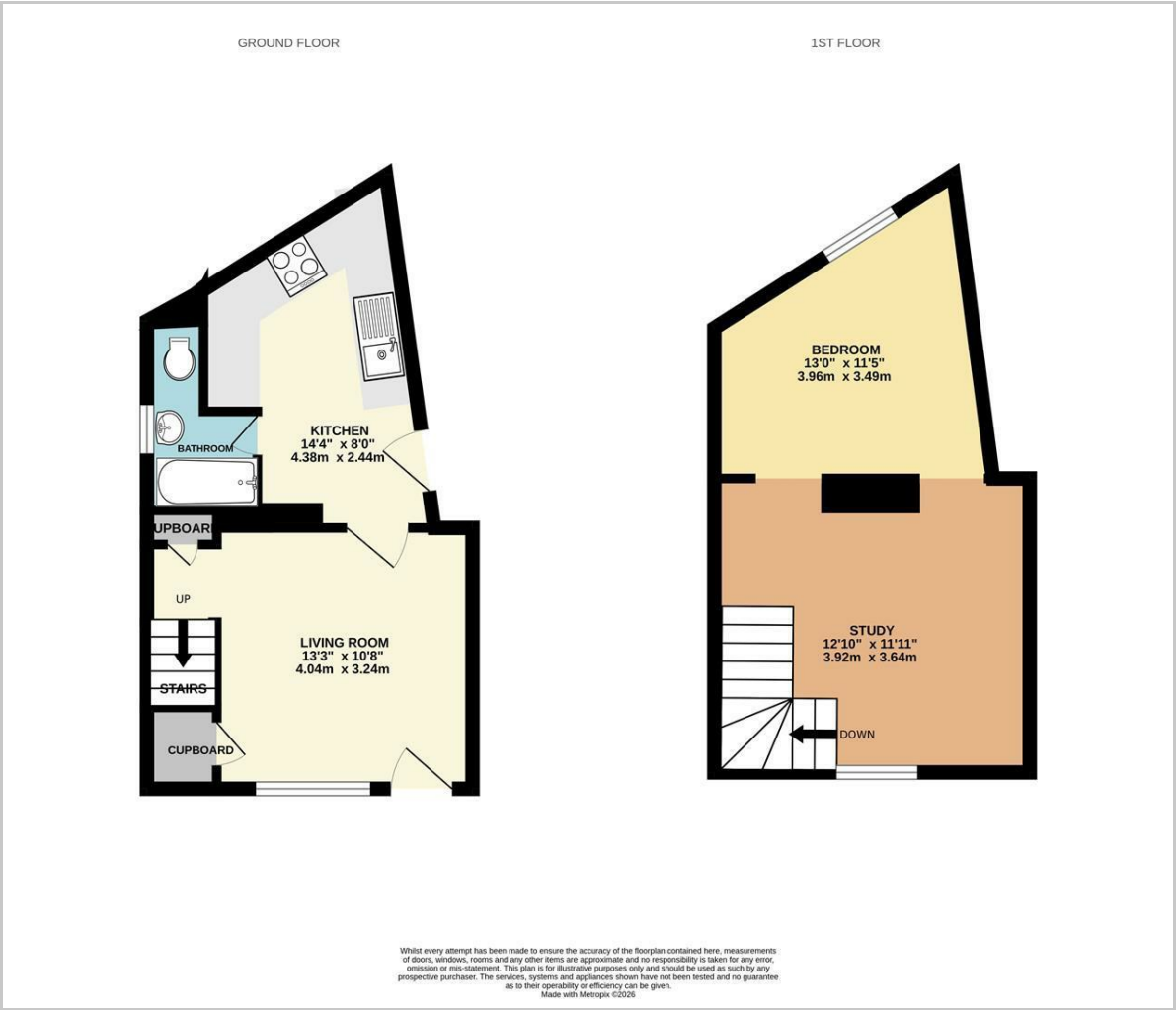

Floor Plan

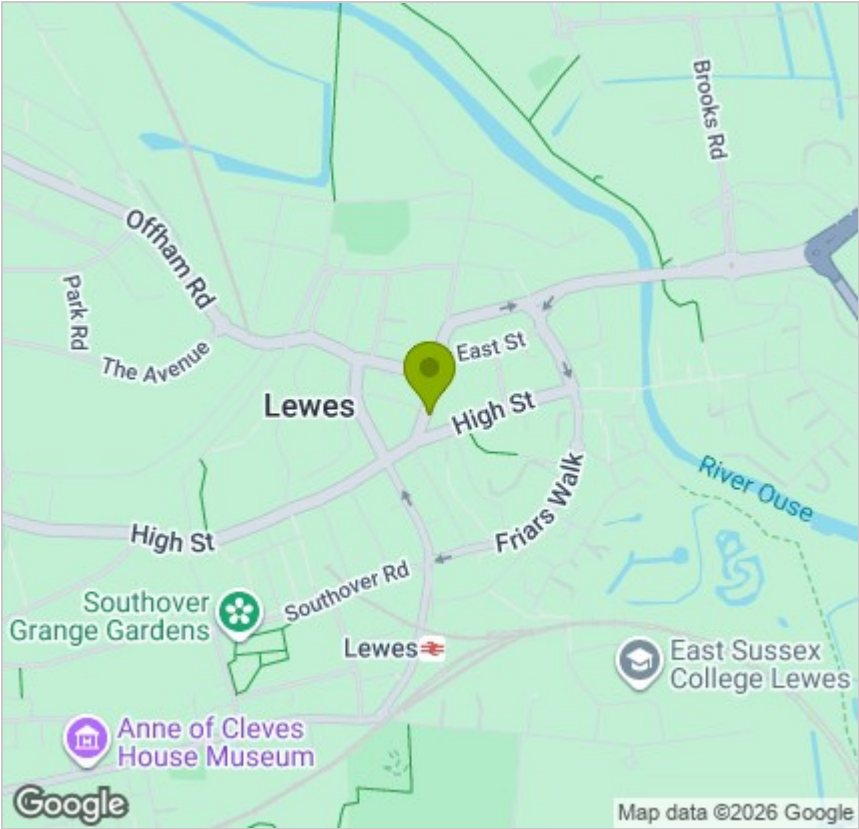
