To the rear, a private enclosed garden offers a combination of patio and lawn, with outdoor storage and space for seating. The property also benefits from 2 allocated parking to the rear.



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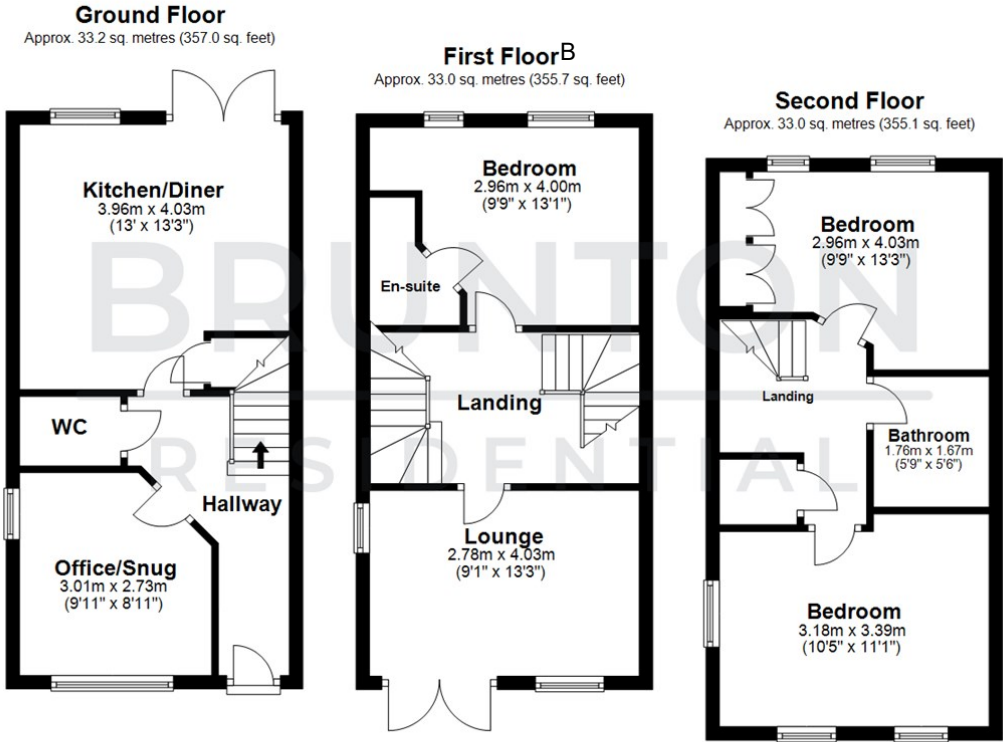

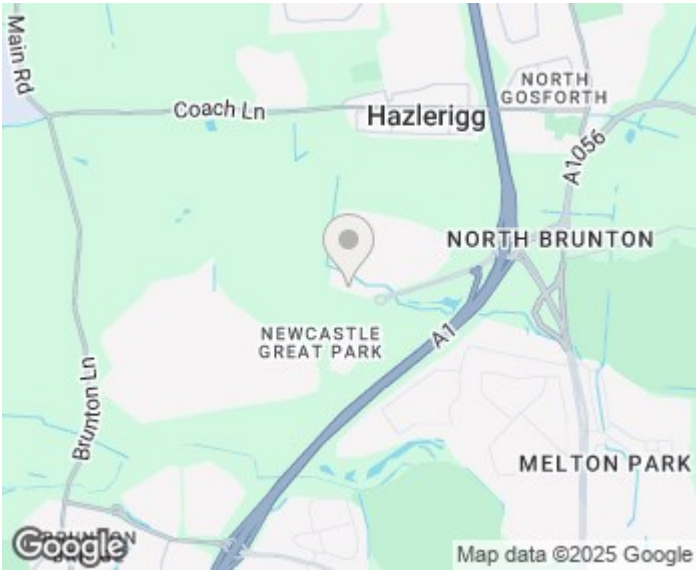
