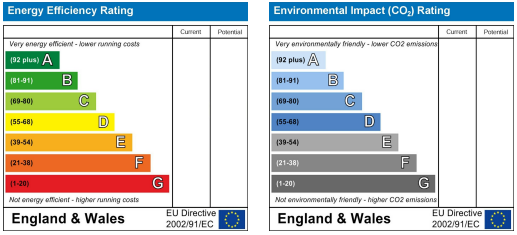
Floor Plan
