## GROUND FLOOR

### ENTRANCE HALL

Ornate ceiling coving, dado rail, entry phone, storage cupboard.

### LOUNGE/DINING ROOM

Holding Deposit (per tenancy)

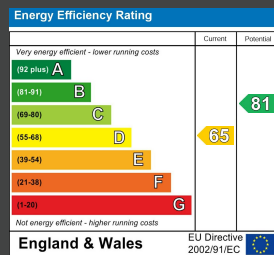


Approximate Floor Area
