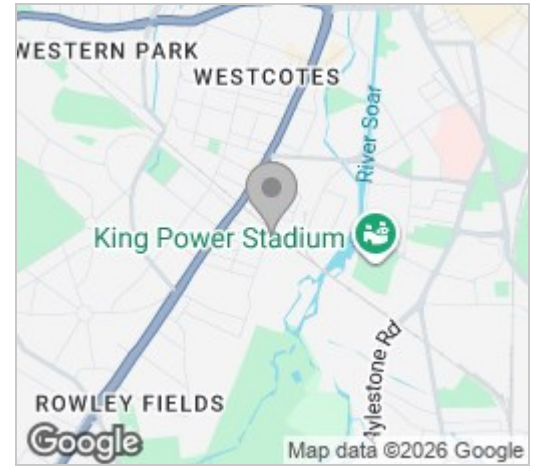

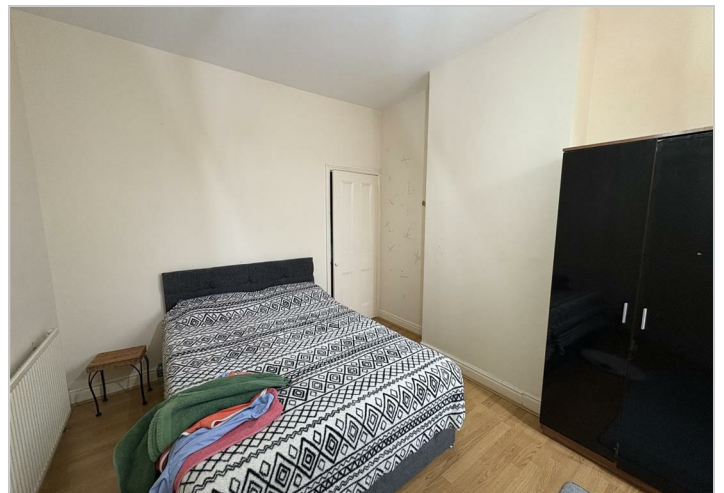
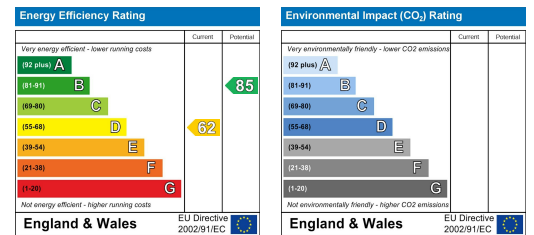
Floor Plan
