The Croft development is located just off Kings Way in Burgess Hill, West Sussex. It is a great area for families, as it has plenty of local amenities, such as a nearby Co-Operative shop, several schools (Birchwood Grove, Woodlands Meed, and Burgess Hill School for Girls), St George's Park nature reserve, and Ditchling Common nearby. 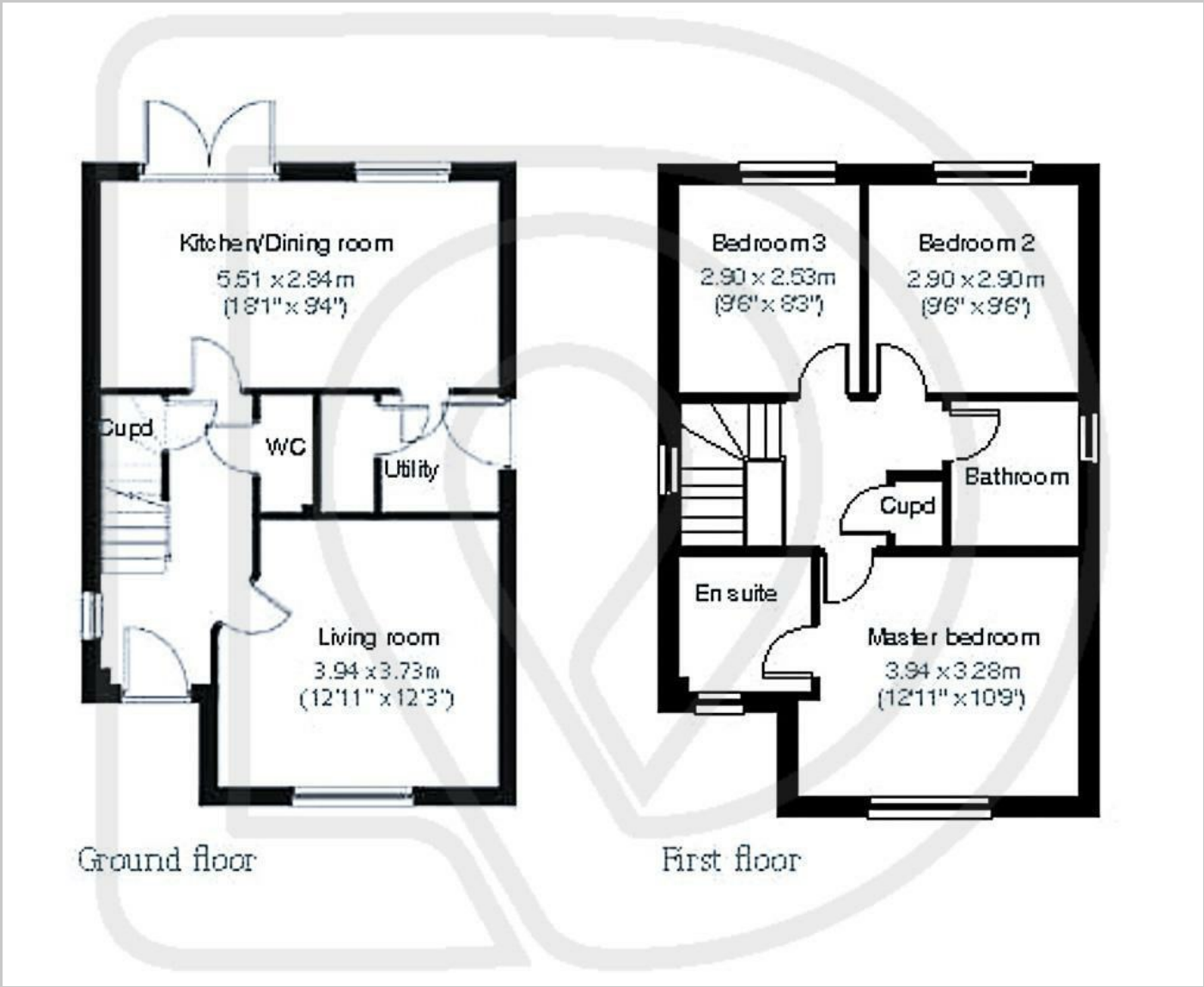

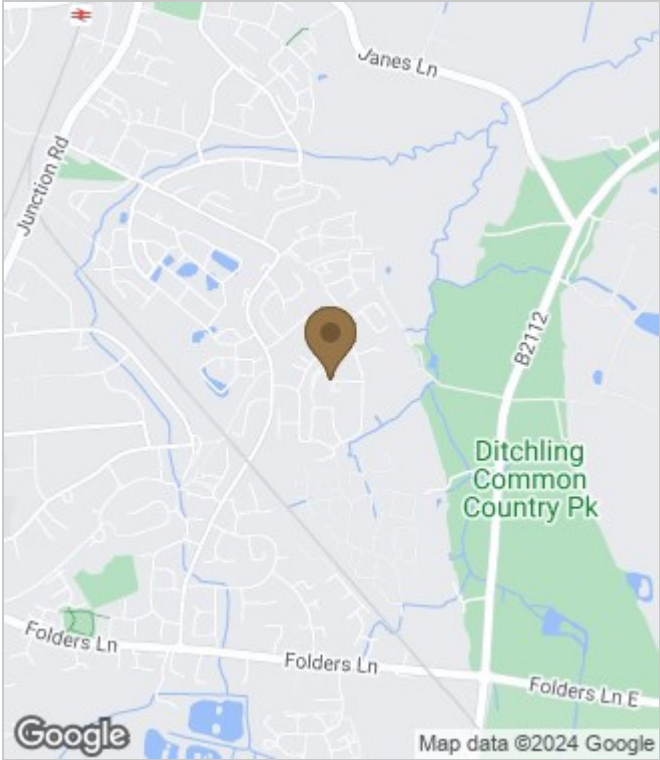
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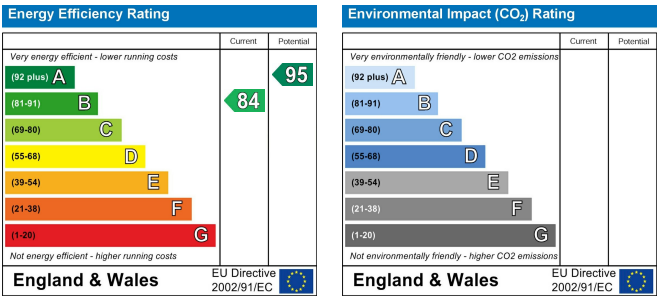
Floor Plans
