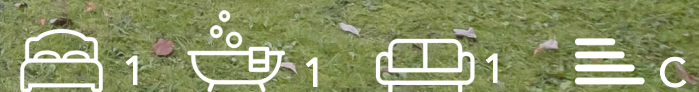

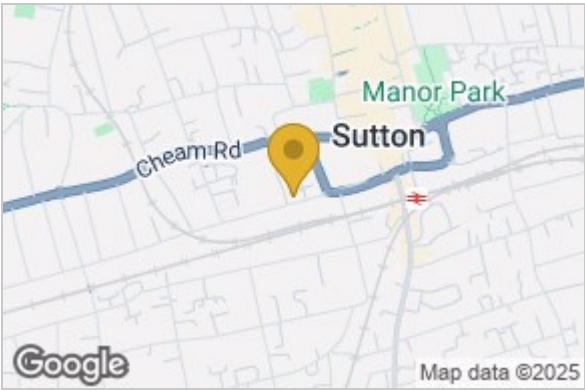

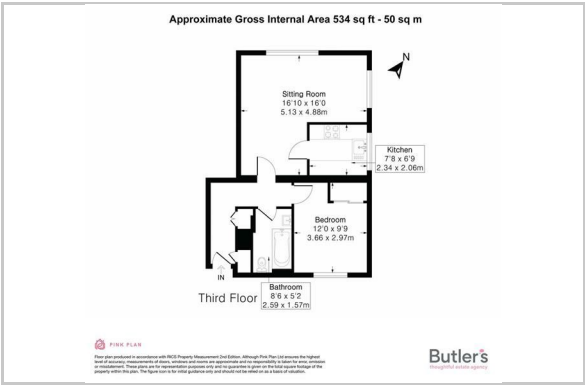
Visitors Parking

Communal Grounds

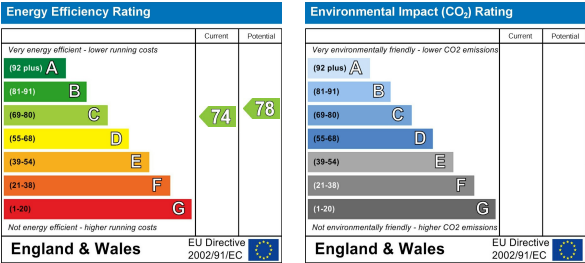
Area Map
