Stamp Duty

Residential property rates

You usually pay Stamp Duty Land Tax (SDLT) on increasing portions of the property price when you buy residential property, for example a house or flat.

The amount you pay depends on:

- when you bought the property
- how much you paid for it
- · whether you're eligible for relief or an exemption

Rates for a single property

You pay SDLT at these rates if, after buying the property, it is the only residential property you own.

You will usually pay 5% on top of these rates if you own another residential property.

Rates from 1 April 2025

Property or lease premium or transfer value SDLT rate Up to £125.000 Zero

The next £125,000 (the portion from £125,001 to £250,000) 2%

The next £675,000 (the portion from £250,001 to £925,000) 5% The next £575,000 (the portion from £925,001 to £1.5 million) 10%

The remaining amount (the portion above £1.5 million) 12%

Example

In April 2025 you buy a house for \pounds 295,000. The SDLT you owe will be calculated as follows:

- 0% on the first £125,000 = £0
- 2% on the second £125,000 = £2,500
- 5% on the final £45,000 = £2,250
- total SDLT = £4,750
