## **Entrance Vestibule**

3'0 x 3'0 (0.91m x 0.91m)

Front facing vestibule, carpeted with white painted walls, door leading to lounge.

## Lounge

13'2 x 13'4 (4.01m x 4.06m)

Front facing lounge with wood laminate flooring, radiator and white painted walls with single light fitting, featuring a decorative wood store.

#### Kitchen

11'1 x 13'10 (3.38m x 4.22m)

Rear facing kitchen with a range of wall and base units in a neutral décor, laminate flooring, integrated oven with gas hobs and over head extractor fan. Stairs off to first floor.

## Sunroom

3'8 x 13'8 (1.12m x 4.17m)

Rear facing exposed stone walls, tiled flooring and radiator, glass windows and door leading to back garden.

## Landing

6'10 x 6'0 (2.08m x 1.83m)

Carpeted stairs & landing area with radiator and single light fitting, doors leading to bedrooms and steps leading to bathroom.

#### **Bedroom 1**

9'8 x 12'0 (2.95m x 3.66m)

Front facing bedroom, carpeted with radiator and single light fitting, featuring built in wardrobes.

## **Bedroom 2**

10'11 x 7'8 (3.33m x 2.34m)

Rear facing bedroom, carpeted with radiator, white painted walls and ceilings with a single light fitting.

## **Bathroom**

5'6 x 6'0 (1.68m x 1.83m)

Rear facing bathroom compromising of white WC, basin and bath with overhead shower, tiled walls and flooring, spotlights and stainless steel heated towel rail.

#### Stamp Duty

Residential property rates

You usually pay Stamp Duty Land Tax (SDLT) on increasing portions of the property price when you buy residential property, for example a house or flat.

The amount you pay depends on:

- · when you bought the property
- · how much you paid for it
- · whether you're eligible for relief or an exemption

Rates for a single property

You pay SDLT at these rates if, after buying the property, it is the only residential property you own.

You will usually pay 5% on top of these rates if you own another residential property.

Rates from 1 April 2025

Property or lease premium or transfer value SDLT rate Up to £125,000 Zero

The next £125,000 (the portion from £125,001 to £250,000) 2% The next £675,000 (the portion from £250,001 to £925,000) 5%

The next £575,000 (the portion from £925,001 to £1.5 million) 10%

The remaining amount (the portion above £1.5 million) 12% Example

In April 2025 you buy a house for £295,000. The SDLT you owe will be calculated as follows:

- 0% on the first £125,000 = £0
- 2% on the second £125,000 = £2,500
- 5% on the final £45,000 = £2,250
- total SDLT = £4,750
