The home boasts an attractive frontage with a striking large bay window and a neat forecourt, creating immediate kerb appeal. Internally, a beautiful entrance hall welcomes you in, finished in warm, neutral tones and complemented by tasteful interiors that set the tone for the rest of the property.

From here, the accommodation flows seamlessly into a spacious open-plan living, dining and kitchen area, creating a cohesive and sociable layout ideal for modern living. To the front of the property, the cosy living area is centred around a charming feature fireplace and enjoys a large bay window that fills the room with natural light. This leads effortlessly into the dining area, which features a further bay window to the rear overlooking the garden, along with an attractive fire surround that enhances the room's character.

The dining space opens into a stylish kitchen fitted with classic shaker-style cabinets in neutral tones, offering both elegance and practicality. From the kitchen, there is access to a useful utility room located at the rear of the property. A convenient downstairs WC completes the ground floor accommodation.

To the first floor, the property offers two generously sized double bedrooms, both benefitting from large bay windows that allow for an abundance of natural light. The third bedroom is a cosy single room, perfect as a child's bedroom, nursery or home office. All bedrooms are served by a well-appointed family bathroom.

Externally, a shared driveway runs alongside the

property and leads to a carport at the rear, providing sheltered off-road parking. The rear garden is initially paved, creating a pleasant seating area, and extends onto a lawned section beyond, offering an ideal space for relaxing, entertaining or family enjoyment.

Location



The market town of Leek is known as the 'Queen of the Staffordshire Moorlands', Leek is a former textile town with a long and fascinating history.

The unspoilt town centre offers a refreshing alternative to from modern shopping malls and has a wealth of independent shops, including former silk mills housing antique and reproduction pine centres, as well as traditional and contemporary furnishings.

Delicious local produce can be found in abundance at traditional butchers, bakers, greengrocers, delicatessens and cafes. Leek is also home to speciality producers of condiments, confectionery, preserves, wine, whisky, craft beers and the traditional Staffordshire oatcake.

Traditional markets abound, both indoors in the beautifully restored Victorian Butter Market and outdoors in the Market Place, offering everything from general goods, antiques and collectables to fine foods and special 'Totally Locally' Sunday markets. And when it comes to wining and dining, you can choose from a tempting selection of cafés,

real ale pubs and restaurants.

Further afield, you'll find the unique, tooth-like rock formations of The Roaches, Rudyard Lake with its picturesque setting and narrow gauge railway and Tittesworth Water, a popular and accessible attraction for visitors of all ages.

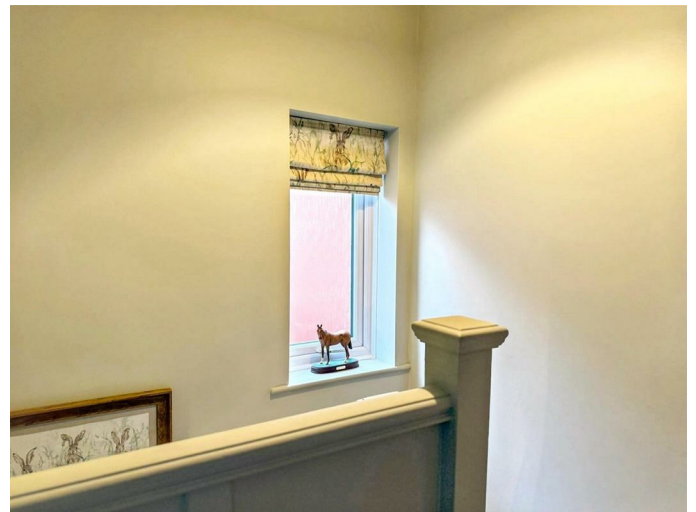

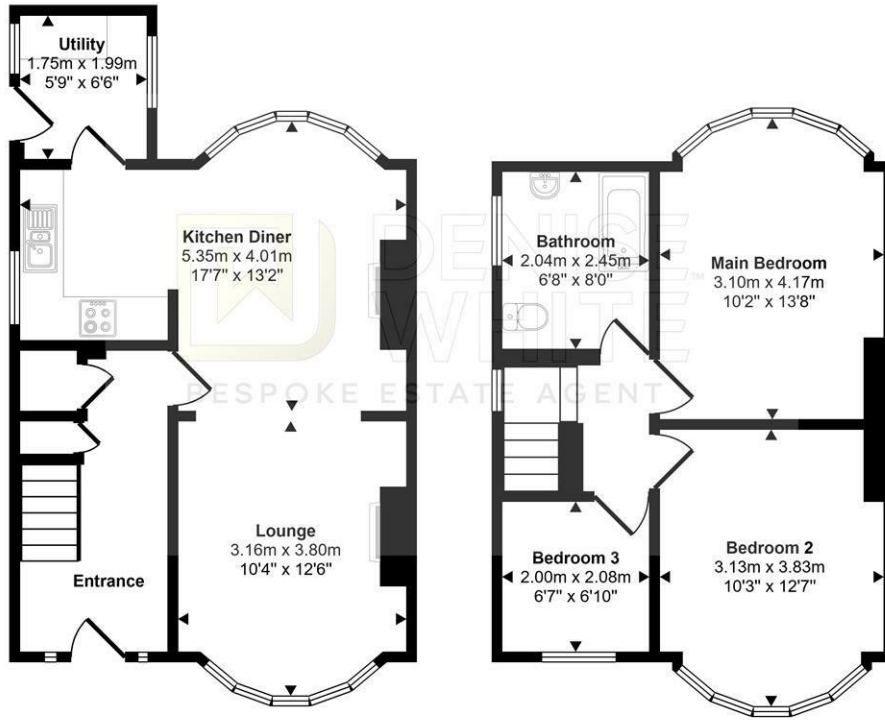

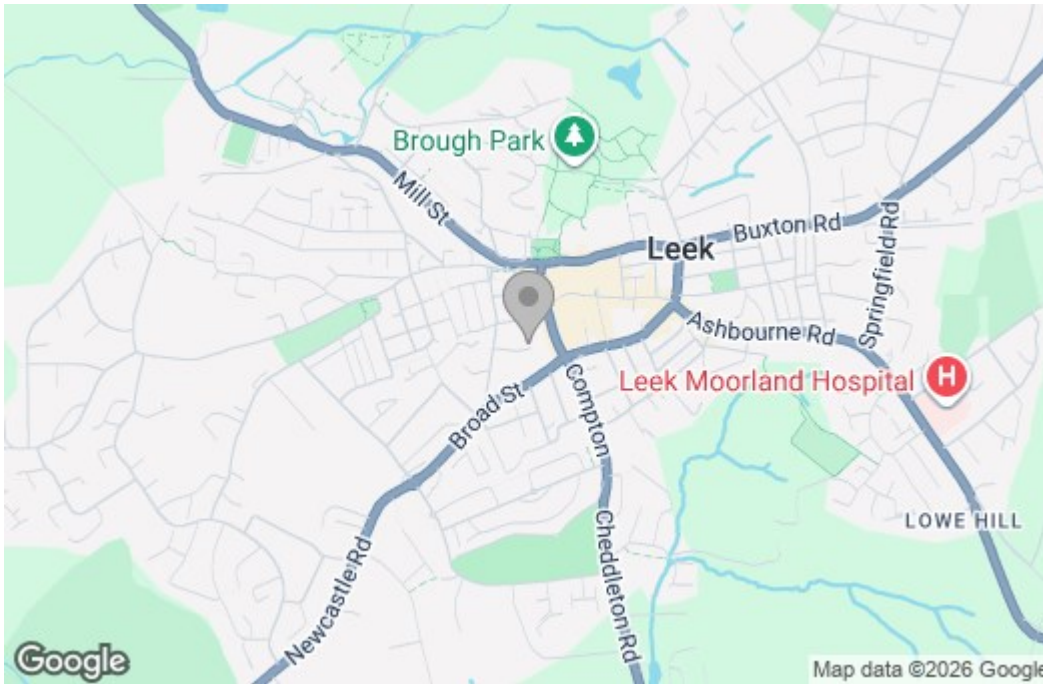


Ground Floor

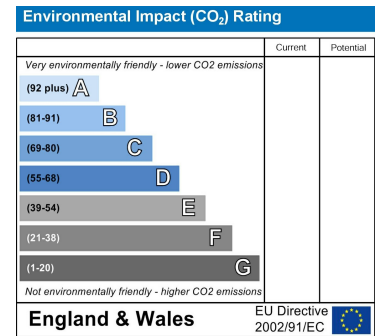
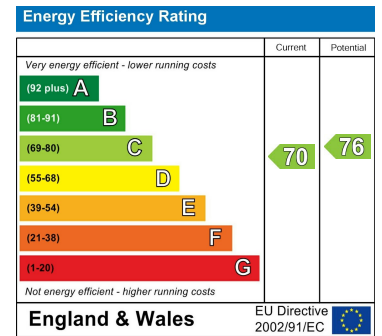
First Floor
