Entrance Hall



Door to front. Door to rear. Storage cupboard with access down to a small basement. Two central heating radiators. Staircase leading to first floor.

To the front is a double glazed window. Wood burning stove. Central heating radiator.

Fitted with a range of wall and base units with work surfaces over incorporating a sink and drainer unit. Plumbing for washing machine. Double oven and gas hob. Central heating radiator. Double glazed window to rear.

Double glazed window. Central heating radiator. Feature cast iron fire.

Double glazed window. Central heating radiator. Feature cast iron fire.

Bathroom







Fitted with a free standing bath with hand held shower attachment, shower cubicle, wash hand basin and wc. In addition there is tiling, heated towel rail and a double glazed window.

Central heating radiator. Two skylight windows.




To the front is a low maintenance garden. To the side is a space providing off road parking. In addition this property has an outbuilding ideal for additional storage.


Floor Plan
