A handsome Victorian terrace set along a quiet residential street, within easy reach of Warwick's historic town centre, Warwick train station and the highly regarded Coten End Primary School.

Extending to around 750 sq ft, the house has been thoughtfully maintained, blending period character with simple, well-considered interiors. A welcoming sitting room sits at the front of the house, centred around a traditional fireplace and large window that draws in natural light.

To the rear, the house opens into a generous dining room with an exposed brick fireplace and timber mantle, creating a warm focal point for everyday living and entertaining. Beyond sits a bright galley kitchen, while a neatly presented bathroom is positioned on the ground floor. A useful cellar beneath the house provides additional storage.

The first floor is arranged as two well-proportioned double bedrooms, both bright and comfortable.

Outside, the rear garden has been thoughtfully landscaped with paving, raised planting beds and built-in seating, creating a private and low-maintenance outdoor space. The house forms part of an attractive terrace of red-brick homes typical of the area.
