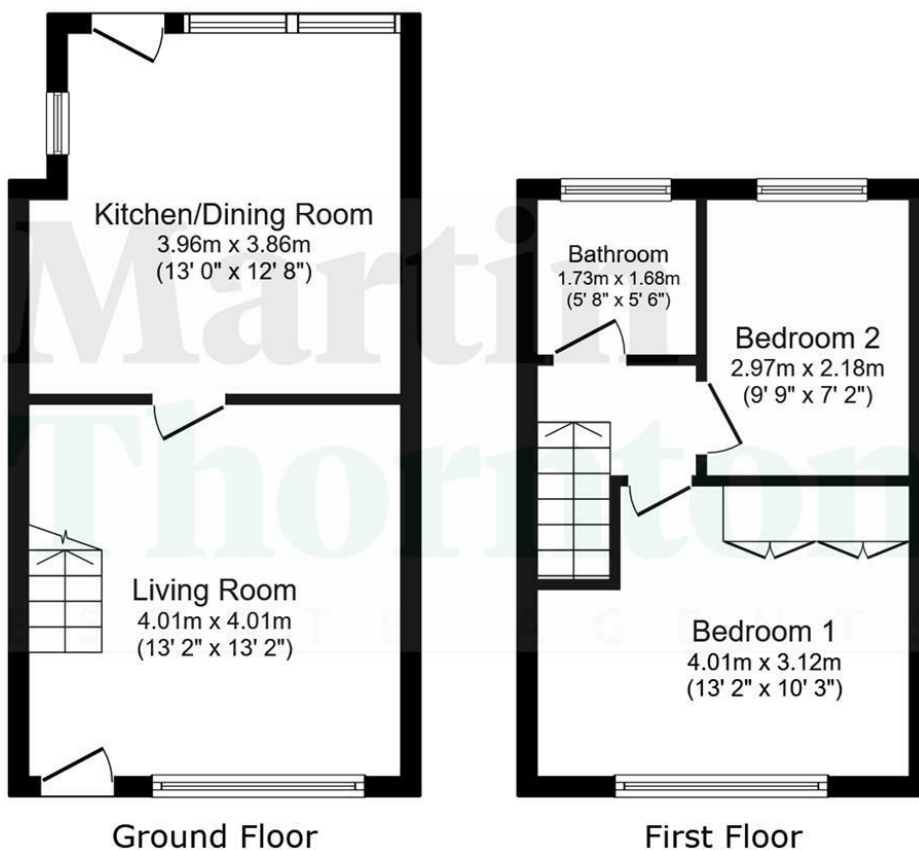

Details



Entrance

A composite entrance door with opaque glazed panels gives access into the living room.

Living Room

This good-sized reception room is positioned at the front of the property and is particularly light and bright, with a broad uPVC double-glazed window that maximises natural lighting. The focal point of the room is a marble finish fire surround with matching inlay and hearth, home to a coal effect living flame gas fire. There is coving to the ceiling, wall light points and a radiator. A staircase rises to the first floor accommodation and a panelled timber door leads into the dining kitchen.



Dining Kitchen

This room has been extended from its original design and creates a large eating and entertaining space at the rear of the property. It has an extensive range of units to high and low levels with worktops and matching upstands, and a one-and-a-half bowl sink with single drainer and mixer tap. Integrated appliances comprise a fan oven and a four-ring gas hob with a canopy style filter hood. There is plumbing and space for an automatic washer and space for a freestanding fridge freezer. Concealed is the boiler for the central heating system. There is plenty of space for a formal dining table. The room has a radiator and enjoys a dual aspect, with rear and side uPVC windows, along with an external composite door with an arched panel.

Details



Bedroom One

This large double bedroom is positioned at the front of the property, being particularly light and bright with large uPVC double-glazed windows. It has a built-in quadruple wardrobe and a good-sized storage cupboard over the staircase. There is space for further freestanding or fitted furniture, coving to the ceiling and a radiator.



Bedroom Two

This double bedroom is positioned at the rear of the property and has a large uPVC window and a radiator.



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Bathroom

The bathroom has a white three-piece suite comprising a bath with a folding shower screen and a Mira 415 wall-mounted shower over, a pedestal wash hand basin and a low-level WC. There is tiling to the walls, an opaque rear uPVC window and a radiator.



External Details

There is a low-level perimeter wall with railings on top and the front garden has been designed for ease of maintenance with gravel and a central circular stone patio, perfect for tubs, pots and planters. The rear garden has been enclosed by perimeter walling and fencing, designed for ease of maintenance. It has a full-width timber decked seating area, which can be a real sun trap with a south-westerly aspect, perfect for the afternoon sun. Adjoining the decking, there is a similarly sized stone flagged seating area, a timber shed and a lockable timber gate at the far end.
