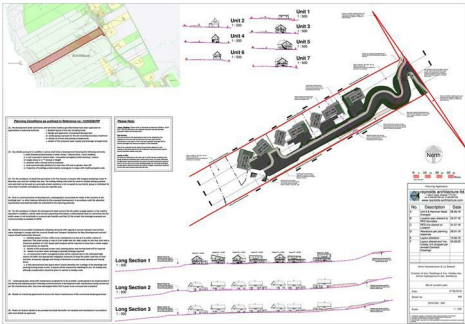
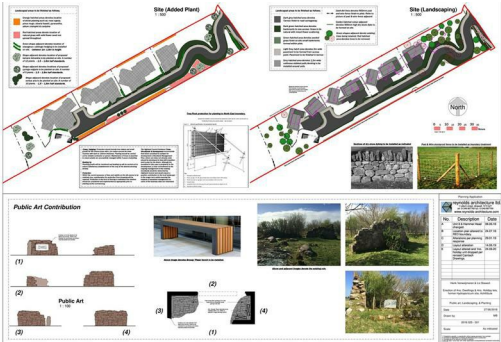

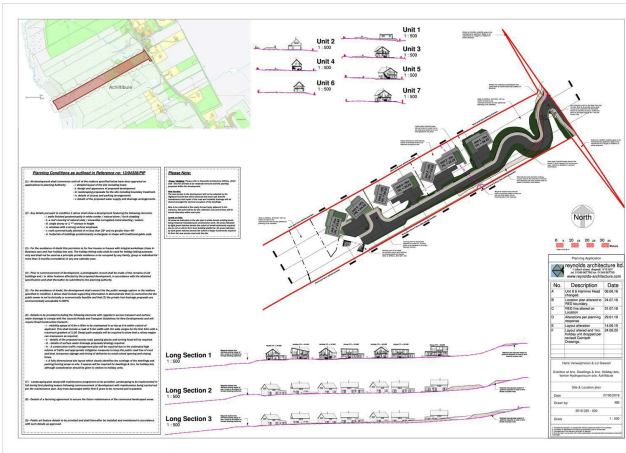
Achiltibuie is a small crofting village on the northwestern coast of Scotland on the popular NC500 route and is located approximately 24 miles north of Ullapool. The area is renowned for its stunning views of the countryside, mountains, coastline and beaches and makes it an ideal location for those interested in geology, fishing, climbing, sailing, cycling and motorcycling. There is an abundance of wildlife including a variety of birds of prey, red deer, badgers, puffins, otters, pine marten, dolphins, whales and seals. The area itself has a range of local amenities which include a community hall, local shop, petrol station, post office, hotel, primary school and a regular doctor's surgery. Ullapool provides secondary schooling, shops, supermarket, leisure centre with swimming pool, health centre, arts centre, cafés and restaurants.



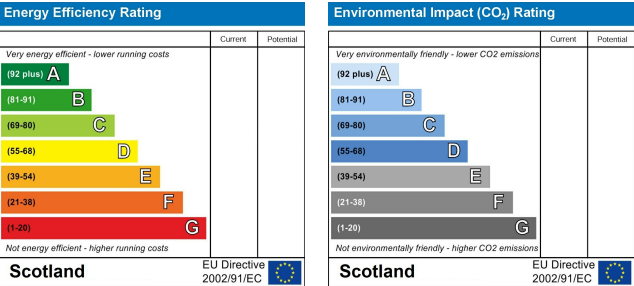
Area Map
