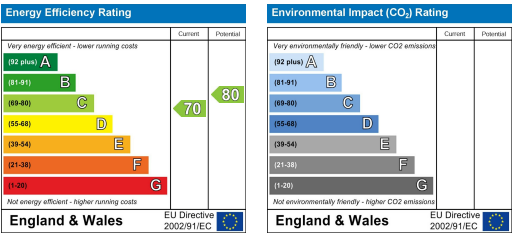
Floor Plan
