Central Hall on Redcross Street in Old Market, was built in 1923-1924 and served for many years as a Methodist Mission Hall and Wesleyan Methodist chapel before closing in the early 1990s and then converted into apartments in the 1990's. Located in the heart of Bristol, within walking distance of Cabot Circus shopping centre, Castle Park, and Bristol Temple Meads station



Highly recommended and offered with no onward chain.






Floor Plan




Area Map
