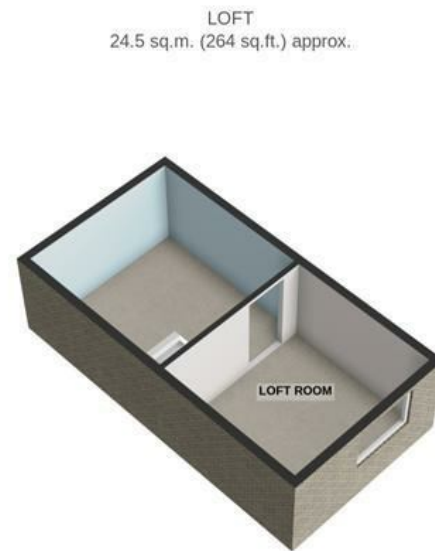

### Entrance

Entrance gained via UPVC door with double glazed opaque, stained and leaded inserts which leads into;

### Entrance Vestibule

Cupboard housing the meters, tiled flooring, door leading into;

### Entrance Hallway

Radiator, telephone point, wood effect laminate flooring, door leading to large closet which also has a pull down ladder providing access to the loft room, door leading to the following room;

### Bedroom Two

12'1 x 10'11  
Large UPVC double glazed window to the front, large radiator, coving.

### Bedroom One

12'1 x 11'9  
Large UPVC double glazed window to the front, large radiator, two in-built wardrobes, coving.

### Loft Room

23'2 x 11'6  
Large UPVC double glazed window to the side, wall mounted 'Potterton' combi boiler. This room has potential to be converted into a further bedroom.

### Lounge

17' x 11'10  
Large UPVC double glazed window to the rear, radiator, television point, space for dining table and chairs, wood effect laminate flooring, coving.

### Separate WC

4'9 x 2'8  
White WC, radiator, part tiled walls, UPVC double glazed opaque window to the side, wood effect laminate flooring.



### Shower Room

Walk in shower with waterfall shower and further shower attachment, vanity wash hand basin, cupboard providing plentiful storage space, tiled walls and floor, wall mounted heated towel rail, extractor vent, wall mounted illuminated mirror, UPVC double glazed opaque window to the side.
