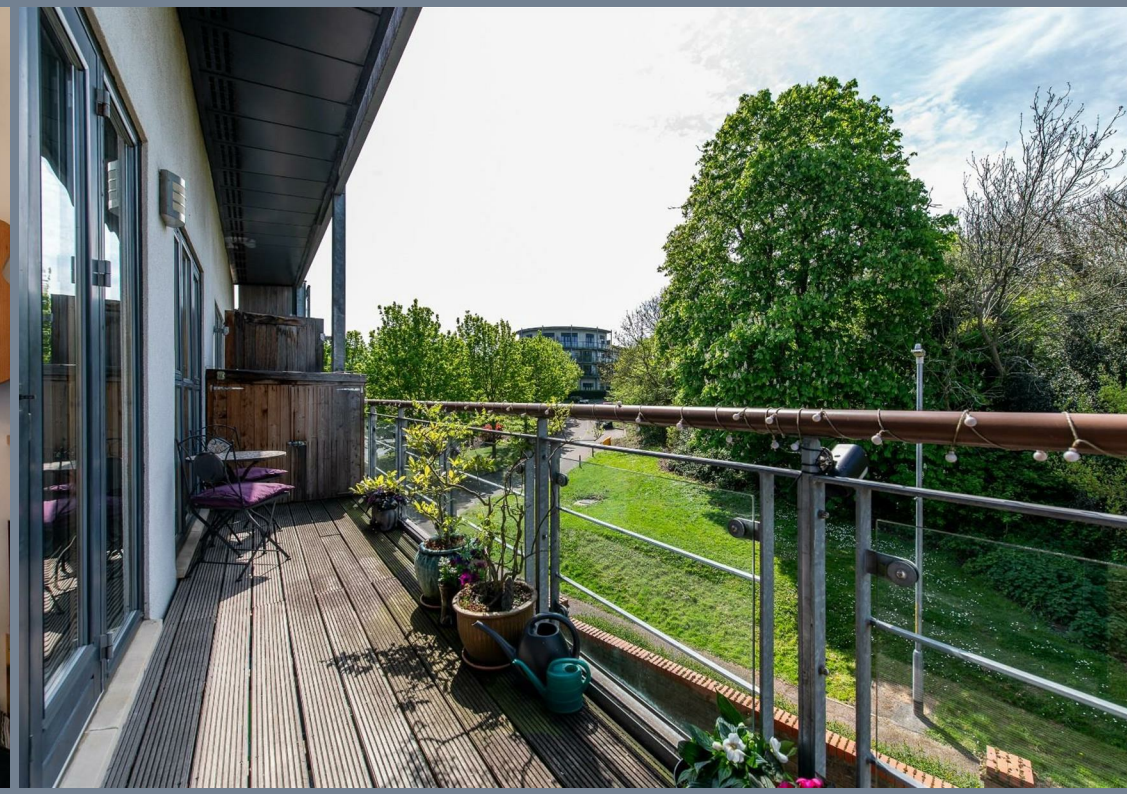

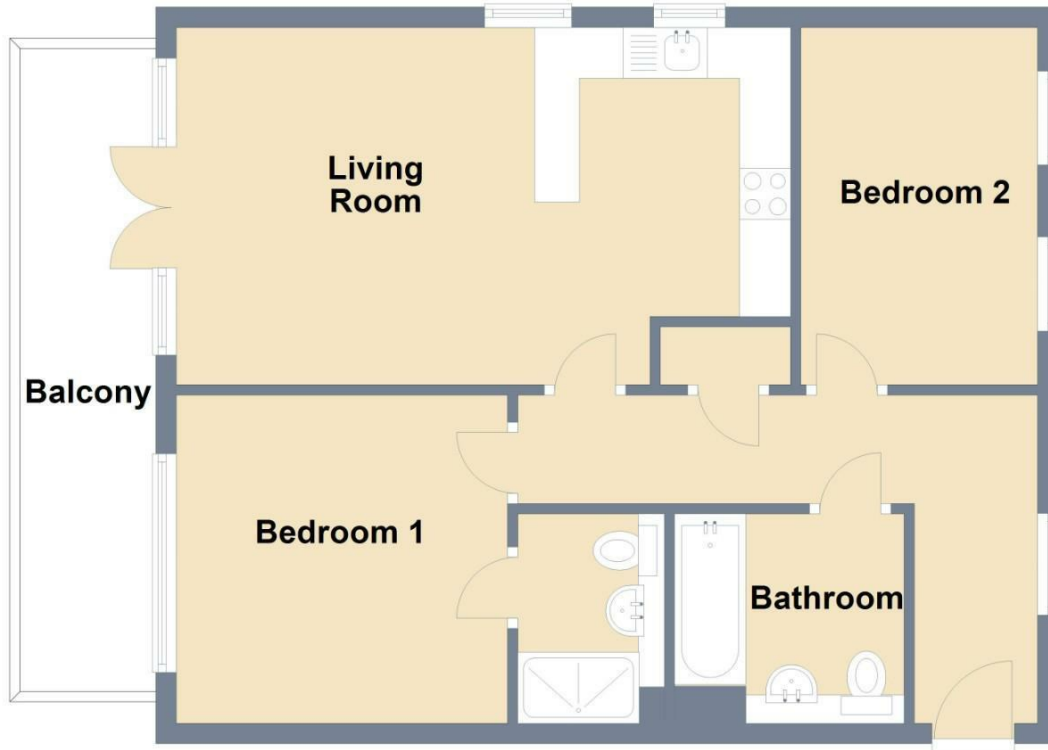

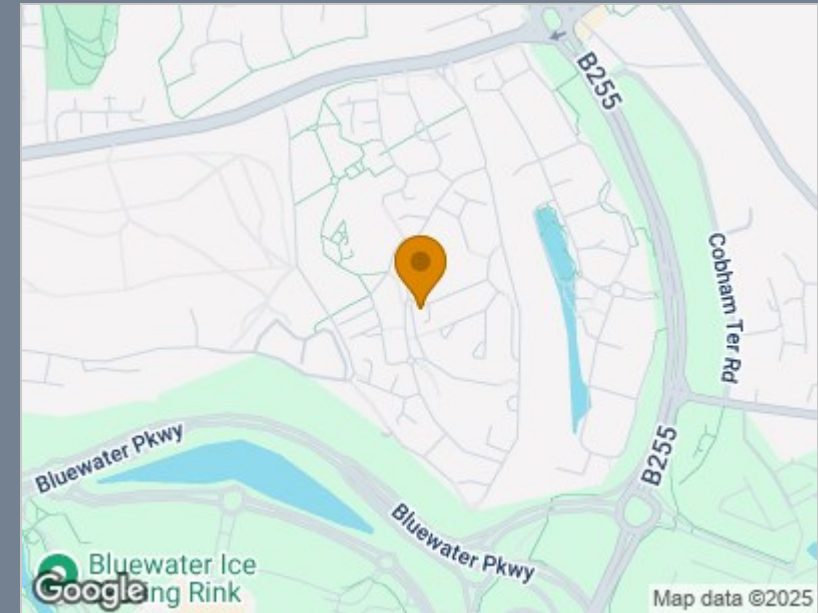


Second Floor
