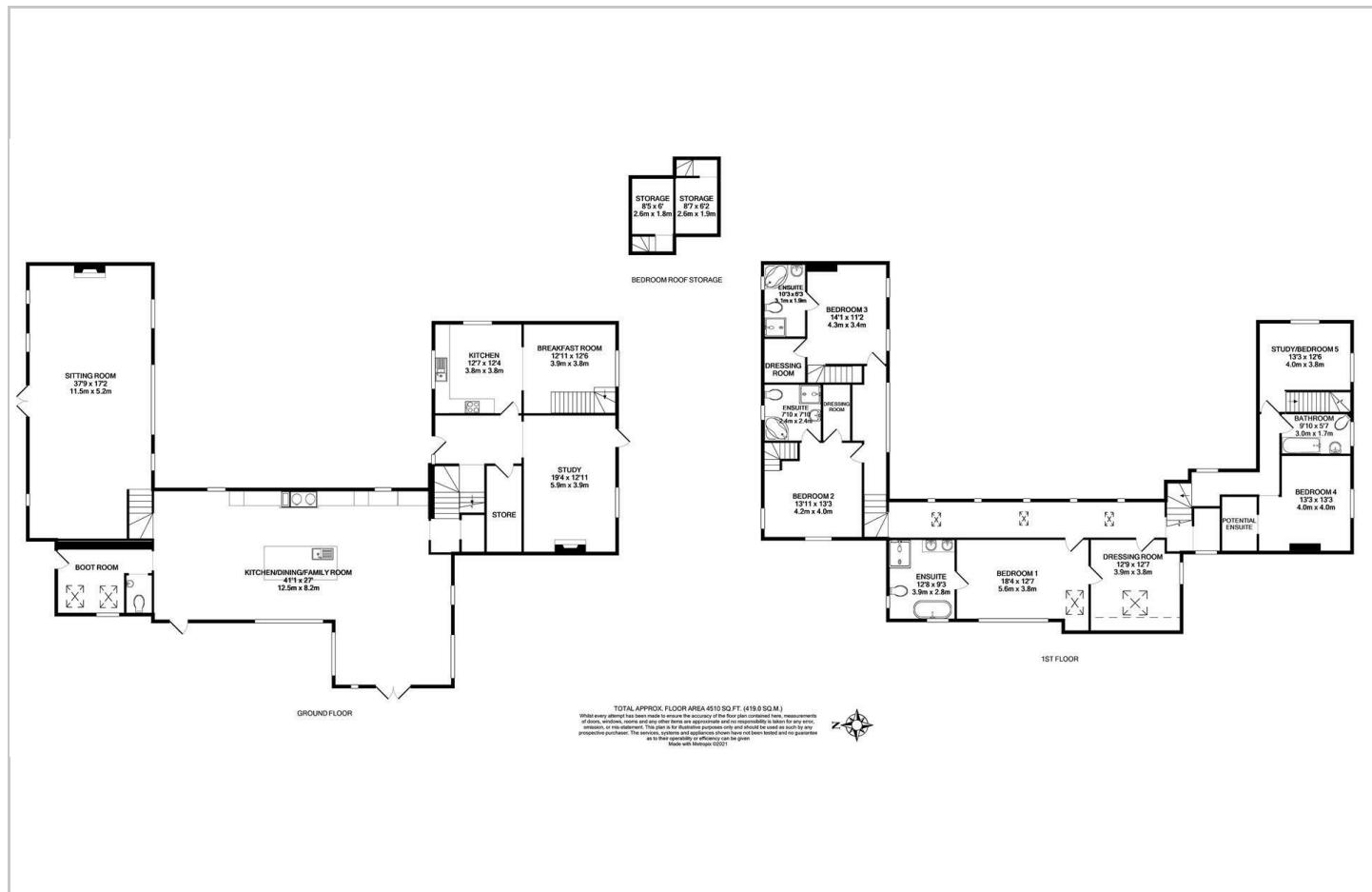
- Five/six bedrooms in total (one utilised as the ensuite dressing room to the principal suite).

- Further dining kitchen, reception room, bathroom and two bedrooms in the original part of the house.



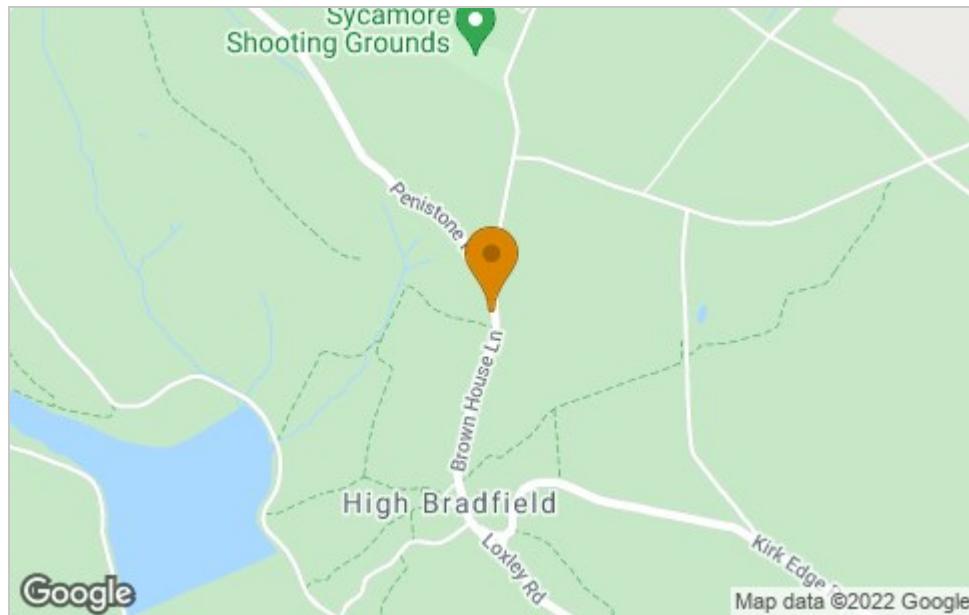

Floor Plan



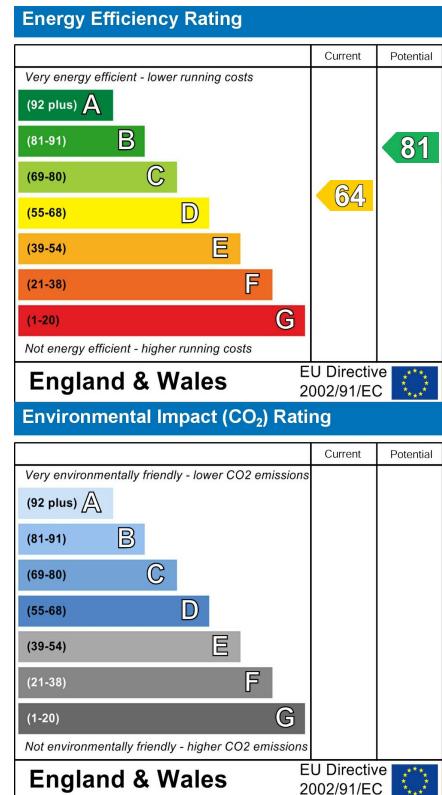
Area Map
